Support Services for Home Patients & Families

- Companionship: Provide social and emotional support, share stories and laughter

- **Vigil Volunteers:** Participate in team rotation to sit vigil at patient's bedside at end of life

- **Pet Therapy:** Volunteers with pets that have obtained pet therapy certifications visit with home and/or hospice care center patients and their families
- Music Therapy: Accomplished musicians create an appropriate relaxed and soothing atmosphere for our patients and their families at home, hospice care centers, or events (auditions/references may be required)
